### Course Description

The C2000 Series MP3s are recordings of Pastor Chuck Smith’s “Through the Bible” messages delivered at Calvary Chapel of Costa Mesa. As you take this course, you will study the Bible verse by verse from Genesis through Revelation (divided in four semesters) by listening to the expository messages, answering the study questions in the course guide, and writing down personal notes from the teachings. This course should give you a broad and deep understanding of God’s Word, which will strengthen your relationship with God and help you understand His will for your life. You should listen to the messages with your Bible open and with a heart that is prepared to hear from God.

### Course Requirements

1. You must **listen to each message completely**, from the beginning through the end.  
In the course guide, you must **answer all the questions** for each message. You **must** write/type the answers at the beginning of your notes for each lesson.
2. You must also complete **at least a half-page** of notes for each message. This must be in a journal, on a CD Rom, Memory Stick, **stapled** printed pages (you must pay 5p for each page). **EMAILED NOTES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED DUE TO POTENTIAL INTERNET ACCESS PROBLEMS.**
3. **Weekly check-in:** you must hand in your course guide and ½ page of notes in the box labeled “Through the Bible Survey”. All pages **must be stapled together**.  
**Please remember to put your name and the Bible Passage and “C2---“ Number (i.e. C2176 Matthew 1-4)**
4. If you need any MP3 CD, please sign up for it. They are £1 per CD  
If you want the printed test questions for your semester, you must sign up for it. There is a printing cost of 5p per sheet – depending on your semester.
5. The following is an example for your notes and test questions. Even if you have the printed copy of the test questions, you **must not** hand these in. **All answers must be in at the top of your journal notes for that specific teaching.**

## Example:

### Notes:

The Gospel of Matthew is the first of the four Gospels and is one of the three Synoptic Gospels (Mark and Luke being the other two). Matthew presents Jesus as Christ the King, written to the Jews. Mark presents Jesus as the perfect Servant, written to the Roman World. Luke presents Jesus as the perfect Man, written to the Greek Culture. John presents Jesus as God, written to the entire world. ....(continue on for at least ½ page).
